Currently Director of Bureau of Macroeconomic Research at the National Bank of Poland, where he served as Deputy Governor since 1998, and previously as Director of the Research Department. He has also served as a member of the G-22 Willard Group on Strengthening Financial Systems; Member of the Supervisory Board, Warsaw Stock Exchange; and Member of the Working Party of G-10 nations on Financial Stability of Emerging Market Economies. He is also a professor at the Department of Economics of the University of Warsaw, and worked as a visiting economist at Dresdner Bank. His publications include *Financial Inflows to Poland, 1900-1996* (Empirica 1998), "Monetary Policy in Poland" (Oesterreichische Nationalbank, Vienna 1997), and "Money and Capital Market Reforms in Poland" (Aldershot, 1994). He completed his Masters, Ph.D. and Dr habil. in Economics at the University of Warsaw.
