- Perspective that of the ECB's staff, with a focus on technical problems:
 - ✓ Complications arising from a lack of historical data and the fact the EMU was itself a
 massive structural change.
 - ✓ Lack of institutions and very quick establishment of ESM and SSM.
- Illustrates the unavoidable constraints central bank staff face when commenting on policy.
- Future economic historians will likely focus on:
 - ✓ Different central banking histories and paradigms.
 - ✓ Decision-making procedures.
 - ✓ Personalities.
